People who are able to ask for and receive support from social groups such as family, friends, church, or community are more resilient to stress than those who either cannot seek support or have none available. While it seems obvious that receiving support would help an individual cope well with stress, there is also evidence that providing support for others in times of crisis is helpful for the person providing the support. This may explain why one in three Americans contributed to the recovery after 9 11 by contributing either 6 time, money, or blood. The final set of factors contributing to resilience is related to coping strategies. Even with the individual characteristics identified above, a person must still utilize coping strategies to respond effectively to an attack. These strategies include stepping back to...
