Its institutional expression in the State Department is the Bureau of Conflict and Stabilization Operations, created in 2011 under the leadership of Secretary Hillary Clinton. One of the Bureau's first projects was to assist the Government of Senegal, which is among the closest U.S. friends and partners in Africa and the Islamic community, in an initiative to end a 30-year secessionist conflict in the southern part of the country, known as the Casamance. A retired career diplomat, Ambassador Jim Bullington, was recalled to active duty to implement this engagement.
